



Crochet Cuddly Car Seat Baby Blanket



Pattern notes:

- Reading the Chart
 - Each blank box is a single crochet, each box with a dot is a bobble stitch
- To create the bobble stitch (bo):
 - *Yarn over (yo), insert hook, yo, pull through stitch, yo, pull through 2* repeat * to * 5 times (until you have 6 loops on your hook), yo, pull through all 6 loops
- At the end of each row, I do not chain one and then turn, I just turn and go straight into my first sc. I find that I get a straighter edge that way. Feel free to chain one, then turn if that is what you prefer.
- To start the blanket, chain 64 for the foundation chain, turn and single crochet in 2nd chain from hook. Complete 63 single crochets (as indicated in row 1 of chart)
- If you choose to change colors, change to the new color after rows 23, 43, and 63; to make each block a different color

Materials:

- **Yarn:** 2 skeins of Baby Bee Baby Lou Lou yarn in your chosen colors (light weight-3; 3.5 ounces-259 yards per skein)
- **Hook:** size G/6-4.25mm
- **Scissors**
- **Tapestry needle:** to weave in ends

Size and gauge:

- **Finished size:** 19 by 17 inches
- **Gauge:** 14 single crochets for 18 rows = 4"x4" square using a size G/6-4.25mm hook

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
